

THE USCIS I-693 EXAM

UNITED STATES CITIZEN & IMMIGRATION SERVICE MEDICAL EXAM FOR CHANGE OF STATUS

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STEP 1 Go to the office of Dr. Ores. Bring your passport.

Blood test for RPR and Varicella antibodies (Chicken Pox)
Skin test for TB is placed on your arm (PPD)
Bring your passport
Bring **any** vaccination records you have.
Visit fee is \$145.00 (cash, check or credit card)

STEP 2 Go to the office of Dr. Ores again (two or three days later).

Skin test (TB) will be examined by the Doctor.
If negative = Done (no Chest x-ray needed)
If positive = Chest x-ray required

Determine which vaccine(s) is needed based on your blood test results.
MMR (measles mumps rubella)
DT (diphtheria tetanus)
VARIVAX (chicken pox)

Send client to NYC DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH if appropriate (free vaccines). You can also choose to buy the vaccines from Dr. Ores

STEP 3 Call the NYC Department of Health (212) 239 1419 to make an appointment. You must make an appointment. NYC DOH address: 303 Ninth Avenue at West 28th Street

get HIV test (oral swab)
get a chest X-ray if needed
get any vaccination(s) you need for the USCIS exam

STEP 4 Return to Dr. Ores office with written proof of vaccination(s) and test results. You can also **FAX** these results to Dr. Ores at 646 – 349 - 5328. You will then receive your **sealed envelope** you can submit to the INS or deliver to your immigration lawyer. Do not open the sealed envelope.
